Use the Act it Out problem solving strategy:

Everett had 7 goldfish crackers in his lunch box. He ate 5 of them during snack. How many crackers did Everett have left?

Fitzgerald had 3 carrots on his plate. His dad gave him some more. Now he has 9 on his plate. How many carrots did his dad just give him?

Georgia had a bag of strawberries. She ate 2 of them for snack. Now she has 4 left in the bag. How many total strawberries did she bring that day?

Holden had 8 coloring tools in his backpack. 3 of them were crayons. The rest were markers. How many markers did he have in his backpack?

Julia had 9 cookies. She wanted to give some to her friends, Wren and Peyton. How many cookies will each person have if she shares them equally? (Don't forget about Julia's share!)
