Step 1: Choose a local "hero"

In class, we have defined heroes as people who help or save other people. We also believe that heroes fix things.

Your child wants to become an expert on this hero: _____

Step 2: Research a local "hero" by using the internet, reading a book, or better yet, schedule a trip to meet your hero by visiting the fire station, hospital, post office, etc.

Find out:

1. How your hero helps others or fixes things
2. What tools he/she uses (hose, stethoscope...)
3. Which personal traits he/she needs for their job (bravery, kindness...)
4. The setting he/she would work in

Step 3: Choose one of the following projects to show what you learned

Poster

Create a poster where you show a local hero with the tools they use. In the background, draw the setting they would be found in. At the bottom write how they save or help people.



Information Book

Write an information book about a local hero. Include a page about each of the following: how they help or save others, what tools they use, the personal traits they need to do their job, and the setting they would work in.

Create a Superhero

Transform your real-life hero into a superhero by giving him or her superpowers and supertraits. Also, think of a villain that would be your superhero's arch nemesis. Think of a creative way to share your superhero with the class (drawing, comic book, painting, clay figurine, poster, etc.)
