**Community Map research**

In order to make our 3D map class project accurate, please research the community organization you have chosen to make. Follow the steps below using the attached research sheet.

1. Go to the actual building for a visit.
2. Take pictures of the inside and outside.
3. Sketch the inside and outside of the building. Include all of the details!
4. List what you see inside and outside your building.
5. Print out a map of Encinitas and clearly show where your organization is on the map. Also, mark where our school is located on the map.
6. Gather materials you might need to make the 3D model of your community organization. Bring them to school so you can build the 3D model.

**Measurement Project**

Choose various things around the house to measure. After measuring something in 4 different ways (student's feet, a different family member's feet, inches, and pencils) discuss why the amounts are different depending on what units you used to measure. Parents- remember to help your child **discover** why the amounts are different for themselves; don't just explain it to him or her. When they discover it themselves they will remember the concept. If they are told the answers, they will easily forget.

**Book Bag**

Please listen to your child read the beginning reader books in his or her book bag at least 3 times each.

Read the story or nonfiction books together and discuss connections to the books and/or what they learned from the books.
