## Add to your Digital Portfolio

1. Find the 2 or 3 photos of your child's opinion writing (on the reading/writing page). The photos will be titled "Opinion writing 1<sup>st</sup> draft," "Opinion writing 2<sup>nd</sup> draft," and "Opinion writing final draft." Have your child look carefully at the pictures and then type an explanation about what he or she did to make each draft better.

Students might discuss the following topics in their reflections:

- handwriting
- sounding out words carefully
- spacing between words
- capital letters
- punctuation
- adding more detail
- changing words or letters so it would make sense
- making sure all sentences were about the same topic

2. Help your child add some information about their year onto the digital portfolio homepage. They might want to write a few sentences about themselves or about this school year. Maybe favorite projects, favorite things about school, or what they learned this year.

## 3. Add reflections to other new pictures.

## Reflections should include:

- the date the reflection was written
- what learning target or skill he/she was practicing in the picture **bonus**:
- how he/she felt at the time of the picture (ex: "It was challenging.")
- any GATE icons he/she used during the learning in the picture
- any scholarly traits used
- other information Mrs. Sah or parents might want to know about the picture

## <u>Math</u>

Help your child complete the math problems in his/her homework folder. Use various strategies to solve the problems (draw a picture, act it out, use math tools, etc.)

\*\*\*Bonus: Take pictures or video of your child working and add it to his/her Digital Portfolio.

This shows practice/mastery of the following math targets:

- I can use strategies help me show addition and subtraction.
- I can solve addition and subtraction word problems.
