Assignment 1: Compass Learning

After you log on, you will see two circle icons: language arts and math. Click on the icons to see the assigned lessons. Please have your child try to complete all of the lessons assigned.

Keep in mind that this is my first time using the program! I tried to assign enough work for two days but it might feel like too much or not enough. PLEASE give me feedback on how the amount of lessons felt. Email me if you have any questions or concerns about Compass Learning. We have teacher meetings on Thursday but I'll be checking email periodically. I'll also be available by email during the school day on Friday. Any feedback on this assignment is appreciated!

Assignment 2: Be a Community Superhero

Together with your child, review our previous learning about community "superheroes." Remember that we learned about firefighters, veterinarians, doctors, etc. We learned that heroes help people and sometimes save people. Heroes could also help plants, animals, and the earth.

Discuss ways that our class could help other people or things in the school or local community. Have your child write a list of 3 ideas he or she had. We will discuss these ideas in class next week and vote for the one we want to do.

Assignment 3: Keep reading!

Make sure your child continues to practice reading with the books in their book bag. Don't forget to return the bag on Monday.
